#### B1. REVIEW OF PERFORMANCE

The Group recorded revenue of approximately RM439.9 million and profit before tax ("PBT") of RM26.4 million for the 4th quarter ended 30th September 2011. The revenue was lower by about 7.3% as compared to the corresponding quarter figures due to the lower average selling price (ASP), lesser volume of shipments and unfavourable US Dollar exchange rate.

Despite relatively high raw material cost and high labour cost resulting from shortage of workers in Malaysia, the Group managed to improve its margin and net profit from improving its operational efficiency and effective cost management.

#### B2. COMPARISON WITH PRECEDING QUARTER'S RESULTS

The Group recorded revenue of approximately RM 439.9 million and PBT of RM 26.4 million for the reporting quarter. In the preceding quarter, the Group recorded a revenue of RM395.2 million and loss before taxation ("LBT") of RM31.8 million

The revenue for the current 4th quarter increased by 11.3% compared with the preceding quarter due mainly to increase in volume of shipments. Likewise, the overall profitability also increased from a LBT of RM 31.8 million to a PBT of RM 26.4 million due to improvement in margin arising from operational efficiency, gain in foreign exchange and reduction in operational cost.

#### **B3. FUTURE PROSPECT**

The recent devastating flood in Thailand has affected a number of HDD vendors and component suppliers resulting in a global shortage of HDD supply. JCY's factory in Saraburi Thailand is fortunate to have avoided the recent flood in Thailand and is able to maintain its production at full capacity.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances and factors beyond our control within the HDD supply chain, we are optimistic that improvement in HDD average selling price (ASP) and opportunity to capture additional global market share due to the worldwide shortage of HDD components will enable the Group to achieve favourable result for the coming quarters.

#### **B4.** VARIANCE FROM PROFIT FORECAST

Not applicable as the Group has not issued any profit forecast.

#### B5. TAXATION

Domestic current income tax is calculated at the statutory tax rate of 25% (2010: 25%) of the estimated assessable profit for the year. Taxation for other jurisdictions is calculated at the rates prevailing in the respective jurisdictions. Certain subsidiaries of the Group enjoy tax exemptions from the relevant authorities on their business income for current and future periods. The computation of deferred tax as at 30 September 2010 has reflected the effects of such exemptions.

#### **B11. MATERIAL LITIGATION**

A subsidiary of the Company, JCY HDD Technology Sdn. Bhd. (JCY HDD), has received letters dated 14 December 2009 from Tenaga Nasional Berhad ("TNB") claiming for additional electricity charges of approximately RM8.36 million. The additional electricity charges were in respect of the electricity charges supposedly undercharged by TNB for the period from September 2007 to November 2009 due to the incorrect meter reading from electricity meters that were either defective or tampered.

JCY HDD had disputed the claims and had discussed with TNB as to their basis and quantification of the additional electricity charges. JCY HDD had on 14 June 2010 met TNB directors to discuss on the matter and had on 28 June 2010 provided TNB with the third party audited production reports as requested by TNB. TNB has reverted with claim of approximately RM8 million on 11 January 2011. However, JCY disagrees with the claim and has engaged legal counsel to challenge the claim and seek independent court assessment of the claim.

The Writ of Summons and Statement of Claim dated 23 February 2011 was served on JCY HDD by TNB claiming for the additional electricity charges in respect of the electricity charges supposedly undercharged by TNB for the period from September 2007 to November 2009 due to the incorrect meter reading from electricity meters that were either defective or tempered. The Company had sought for solicitor's advise on the necessary course of action to be taken in relation to the aforesaid Write of Summons. The Company had filed into court its Defence and Counter-Claim on 29 April 2011. On 19 August 2011, a mediation process that was arranged by the Court took place at Penang High Court between the Company and TNB's representatives. There was no settlement reached and TNB requested the Company to raise the amount it had offered. On 27 October 2011, an application has been filed into the Court to have certain preliminary question of law tried and determined by the judge before trial. The Judge has fixed the preliminary question of law for hearing on 25 November 2011.

There will be no significant financial impact arising from the Writ of Summons and Statement of Claim served of JCY HDD as the major shareholder has undertaken that they would make good to the amount claimed by TNB.
