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NOTES TO THE CONDENSED INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE QUARTER ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2012

A1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in compliance with FRS 134 - Interim Financial Reporting and Paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad's Listing Requirements. The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 30 September 2011 and the accompanying explanatory notes attached to this interim financial statements. These explanatory notes provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of JCY International Berhad and its subsidiaries ("the Group") since the year ended 30 September 2011.

Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS Framework)

On 19 November 2011, the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS Framework).

The Group will be required to prepare financial statements using the MFRS Framework in its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 30 September 2013.

The financial performance and financial position prepared under current accounting framework would not be significantly different if prepared under the MFRS Framework.

A3. AUDITORS' REPORT IN PRECEDING FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The auditors' report on the financial statements for the preceding year was not subject to any audit qualification.

A4. SEASONAL OR CYCLICAL FACTORS

The Group does not experience significant fluctuations in operations due to seasonal factors, although demand for hard disk drive ("HDD") components tends to increase slightly during the last quarter of the financial year as a result of higher demand for HDDs.

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows during the financial period ended 30 September 2012.

A8. DEBTS AND EQUITY SECURITIES

Detailed Analysis for current quarter and financial year

The Group recorded a revenue of RM536 million for the reporting quarter, which increased by 22.0% compared to previous year corresponding quarter, this was due mainly to the better Average Selling Prices ("ASP") and favourable exchange rate during the reporting quarter, despite the slight decrease in volumes shipped. The Group also recorded a revenue of RM2,245 million for the reporting financial year, which increased by 34.3% compared to previous year, this was due mainly to the better ASP as a result of shortages in HDD mechanical components after the October 2011 Thailand floods, favourable exchange rates and higher volumes shipped during the first 3 quarters of the reporting financial year.

The Group recorded a net profit of RM10.5 million for the reporting quarter, which reduced by 58.7% compared to previous year corresponding quarter, this was due mainly to the higher operating cost for the reporting quarter. The Group also recorded a net profit of RM441 million for the reporting financial year, which increased by 3,176.6% compared to previous year, this was due mainly to the better revenue achieved as explained above coupled with effective products mix and continuing efficient cost management during the reporting financial year.

For Malaysia segment, factors affecting the improvement or reduction in revenue and net profit for the reporting quarter and reporting financial year compared to previously year corresponding periods are similar to the those affecting the Group as discussed above.

For Thailand segment, the reduction in revenue in the reporting quarter compared to previous year corresponding quarter was due mainly to lower volumes shipped. The segment also recorded a profit of RM2.7 million in the reporting quarter compared to a loss position in previous year corresponding quarter, this was due mainly to favourable exchange rate during the reporting quarter. The revenue for the reporting financial year for the segment improved by 24.7% compared to previous financial year was due mainly to the better ASP and higher volumes shipped, while the widening of loss in the reporting financial year compared to previous financial year was due mainly to the higher labour costs as a result of change in minimum wage policy.

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ADDITIONAL NOTES REQUIRED BY THE LISTING REQUIREMENT OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

B2. COMPARISON WITH PRECEDING QUARTER'S RESULTS

The Group recorded a revenue of approximately RM536.4 million for the reporting quarter or a reduction of 6.4% compared to preceding quarter ended 30 June 2012, this was due mainly to lower volumes shipped during the reporting quarter.

The Group also recorded a net profit of RM10.5 million for the reporting quarter or a reduction of 90.0% compared to preceding quarter ended 30 June 2012, this was due mainly to the reduction in revenue as discussed above, coupled with higher operating costs and exchange losses during the reporting quarter.

B3. FUTURE PROSPECT

Although we believe the long-term outlook for HDD storage media continues to be positive, uncertainties in the global economy are affecting near term demand growth. Due to uncertain TAM (Total Addressable Market) outlook, major HDD vendors' build plan may be lower in the next quarter. HDD vendors and components producers are encountering pressure of cost increase arising from the increase in the labour cost in the Asian Pacific Region.

Pressures on the reduction of ASP (Average Selling Price) and slower growth of TAM coupled with the labour cost increase and stronger Malaysian Ringgit may affect our future earnings. However, JCY will continue to leverage on its competitive strength of its multi-products strategy and its continuing emphasis on productivity improvements to reduce its cost structure.

Barring unforeseen circumstances and factors beyond our control over our production planning and HDD supply chain, we are optimistic of our ability to maintain or improve our market share.

B4. VARIANCE FROM PROFIT FORECAST

Not applicable as the Group has not issued any profit forecast for the period under review.

B5. TAXATION

Domestic current income tax is calculated at the statutory tax rate of 25% (2011: 25%) of the estimated assessable profit for the year. Taxation for other jurisdictions is calculated at the rates prevailing in the respective jurisdictions. Certain subsidiaries of the Group enjoy tax exemptions from the relevant authorities on their business income for current and future periods. The computation of deferred tax as at 30 September 2012 has reflected the effects of such exemptions.

B10. MATERIAL LITIGATION

There is no major changes to material litigation since the last statement of financial position date as of 30 September 2011, save for:-

Tenaga Nasional Berhad ("TNB") vs JCY HDD Technology Sdn Bhd ("JCY HDD")

On 27 October 2011, an application was filed into the Court to have certain preliminary question of law tried and determined by the judge before trial. The Judge fixed the preliminary question of law for hearing on 25 November 2011. On 25 November 2011, the Judge had reserved decision and would deliver his decision on 15 December 2011.

On 15 December 2011, the Judge fixed for decision for the case that TNB's claim is only restricted to 3 months backcharges. Therefore, JCY HDD is only required to pay to TNB for an amount of approximately RM1.05 million. However, TNB had filed an appeal to the Court of Appeal against the decision of the High Court made on 15 December 2011.

This matter has been fixed for Full Trial on 13th and 14th May 2013. A further Case management date has been fixed on 14th January 2013.

There will be no significant financial impact arising from the case as the major shareholder of the Company has undertaken to indemnify the Company for any claim awarded.
